I should like to congratulate DEMAND in raising environmental issues associated with NEMA. The County Council is pleased to be associated with this campaign and has already co-ordinated the local government response to consultation on flight paths. Designation of NEMA is now the only realistic option to control night flights and noise levels generally. NEMA has the largest number of night flights of any UK airport and there is likely to be pressure for further expansion. The County Council wants to be a good neighbour to the Airport but NEMA needs seriously to consider its position and whether it is being a good neighbour to the local community.
