Nottingham East Midlands Airport is growing

This airport's primary business plan is to extend its night time freight business by a forecasted 5 to 11 times the current numbers over the next 20 years. As this happens, people across the East Midlands will be increasingly affected by night time noise and other pollution, from the airports unregulated commercial activities.

However, a new campaign called DEMAND has been set up with one specific aim in mind: to persuade the Government to *designate* Nottingham East Midlands Airport.

Designation under the 1982 Civil Aviation Act passes responsibility to the Government to monitor and control the number of flights being operated at an airport. Night flights are limited under the scheme and any expansion of the airport's operations subjected to a more stringent consultation process.

In view of the attitude shown by this airport towards consultation and its continuing rapid expansion in recent years, we need protection now.
